Rosemarie Latham Highlights Opponent's Lack of Campaign Activity Amid Fundraising for Future State Senate Run

DeLand, FL — Rosemarie Latham, the Democratic candidate for Florida House District 29, is calling attention to her opponent's absence from the campaign trail and his apparent disinterest in the current election. Despite raising significant campaign funds, Rep. Webster Barnaby has yet to spend any of it on voter outreach, campaign events, or community engagement.

Tom Wright in State Senate District 8. This revelation suggests that Barnaby's priority is climbing the political ladder, rather than serving the people of District 29.

"Floridians deserve a representative who is present, engaged, and committed to solving the issues that matter most to our community—like healthcare access, infrastructure, and flood protection. Instead, my opponent seems content to raise money for his next political opportunity, ignoring the people who need him now," Latham continued.
